PLEASE BRING WITH YOU:

- ✓ Some minor testing will take place so you will need to have your child with you.
- ✓ Your child's Birth Certificate
- ✓ Your child's Social Security number (voluntary identification and program use)
- ✓ Your child's shot record, you may look up the required immunization records on our website at www.sedalia200.com Click on "District Information" and "Special Services".
- ✓ Your proof of residence (such as a utility bill or rental agreement, something with your address on it)
- ✓ Parents please bring a form of your own personal ID (drivers license is fine)
- ✓ The form "Missouri Eye Exam Form for School" from a licensed Optometrist or eye doctor. Missouri law requires a comprehensive eye exam for all students entering kindergarten by January 1, 2010.

How do I enroll?



If parents do not have proper documentation at the time of enrollment, they will be permitted to complete the enrollment forms and procedures; however the child will not be enrolled until all documents are on file. While at the enrollment we will give your child a hearing and vision screening and check their shot record.

CURRENT IMMUNIZATION (shot) RECORDS ARE ESSENTIAL:

In addition to other required immunizations, two (2) doses of the chicken pox (varicella) vaccine or reliable proof of chicken pox disease from an MD or DO will be required for all students entering Kindergarten. State law does not allow any student who does not have all required immunizations up-to-date to attend school.
